- No PM activities.

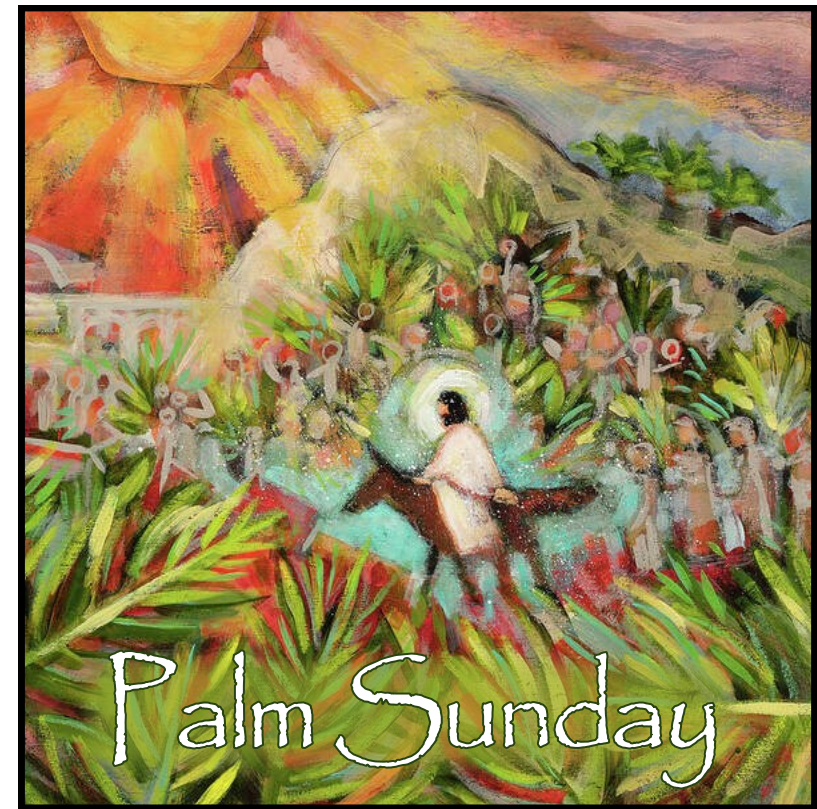
